TJ Jacobs and Tom Hutchinson will be attending Trail Building School to become crew leaders. Paulding Chapter is paying the tuition as voted on in an earlier meeting.

Dave Senecal and Scott Martin will be attending the FATS BOD meetings in South Carolina in February. Dave will be making a presentation to the group on the topic of utilizing community volunteers.

Paulding SORBA group was encouraged to join other chapter group rides and work parties when possible.

Future calendar events include the 2009 Assault on Brushy Mountain with a tentative date in September subject to change. Need to plan ahead to make this a very successful fundraising event.

IMBA Trail Crew will be visiting sometime in fall of 2009. A date will be established later.

Silver Comet Side trail is in need of maintenance. Members are encouraged to assist with maintaining sections of the trail.
